Linemen can be stranded on a pole if they come into contact with energized electrical lines, or experience heat stroke, a heart attack or other condition that prevents them from climbing down. That's why OSHA requires linemen to receive pole-top rescue safety training annually. Roughrider held this training March 24 in Dickinson and March 25 in Hazen. During the training, linemen climb a pole, secure a rope around the waist of a 200-pound mannequin, and lower the "body" to the ground. Thanks in part to scheduled safety training, Roughrider's linemen are equipped to react quickly and efficiently, and bring their co-worker and friend home safely, should an accident ever occur.

Report from

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MARCH 26, 2021

Call to Order: A Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of Roughrider Electric Cooperative, Inc. (Roughrider) was called to order at 10:05 Central Time at Hazen headquarters of the cooperative at 800 Highway Dr., Hazen, North Dakota.

Agenda: The Board approved the agenda as amended.

Minutes of the previous meeting: The Board reviewed and approved the minutes of the Feb. 19, 2021, meeting.

Consent Agenda: The Board reviewed, discussed and approved the Consent Agenda, including proposed membership applications, service connects and assignments, proposed cancellations of membership, and requests for retirement of capital credit accounts.

Co-General Managers' report: Don Franklund and Travis Kupper presented the Co-General Managers' report. This past month, they held an employee WebEx meeting on March 10, 2021, with Roughrider employees. Discussion included a pandemic update, Federal COVID-19 sick leave, vaccinations, the upcoming annual meeting, and the Southwest Power Pool winter event.

2021 Annual Meeting: Management recommended holding the annual meeting in a format similar to that which was held in 2020. Further discussion ensued, and the consensus was to hold a drive-in annual meeting on June 2, 2021, at 2 p.m. MT in Dickinson, at a location to be determined, and it will be live-streamed. Mail-in voting will be offered, as well.

Chief Financial Officer report: Mr. Craigmile reviewed Roughrider's financial statistics with the Board and noted that its financial ratios remain above the Rural Utilities Service minimum requirements. Various components of the Financial Report were discussed among the Board and Mr. Craigmile.

Operations and Construction report: Mr. Bentz referred the Board to his written report. He noted it has been a good year to get line patrol done. In addition, Roughrider has a lot of new service requests, including 17 in the last week.

Upcoming meetings: The next Board meeting was set for 10 a.m. Central Time on April 30, 2021, at Roughrider's office in Hazen, North Dakota.

Adjournment: There being no other business, upon motion made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting adjourned. ■

Pole testing scheduled



Roughrider Electric Cooperative is testing distribution poles within the Gorham and Skunk Hill Substations around the areas of Fairfield; Fryburg Substation around Fryburg; Russian Creek Substation north of Dickinson and New Hradec and west of Manning; and within the Hazen Substation near Hazen. Work is slated from mid-April to mid-May. Testing will continue until the work is completed.

Inspection consists of team members accessing all cooperative distribution lines using four-wheelers, and testing each pole for rot and other damage.

The cooperative will be contacting members who are served off of these substations.

For your safety and theirs, do not approach the pole-testing crew. We continue to be prudent and practice social distancing.

Thank you, members, for your understanding as we work to make the system as reliable as possible. ■

Scammers will say and do anything to make money, and some of their recent targets occurred in neighboring electric cooperative service areas. Around the middle of March, a handful of people reported receiving calls in which they were told they needed to pay a certain amount of their bill within a short amount of time, or their power would be disconnected.

At Roughrider Electric Cooperative, we would never ask for a credit card number over the phone! We offer a variety of payment methods that should be used by our members.

you to view and pay your bill, print statements, receive important co-op updates, compare electrical usage and more ... whenever it works best for you.



Basin Electric Power Cooperative scholarship





What are capital credits?

Roughrider Electric Cooperative is a nonprofit business. We exist only to provide goods and services to you, our members; not to make a profit for a shareholder or investor. Cooperatives are operated to provide at-cost electric service to their members.

When all the expenses are paid, the cooperative's margins are credited to you in the form of capital credits. As the financial condition of your cooperative allows, you are paid these capital credits. In the meantime, your capital credits are your equity in the cooperative.

Refunds are allocated based on the amount of business a member does with the cooperative – the more electricity used, the larger the capital credit check.
